HURRICANE PET PREPAREDNESS CHECKLIST

- ✓ Have your pet MICROCHIPPED!
- ✓ If microchipped, make sure contact information is up to date.
- ✓ Pet's vaccines current. (Critical if boarding pet).
- ✓ Pet's crucial medications with instructions.
- ✓ Medical records in waterproof container.
- ✓ First aid kit.
- ✓ Name & number of your pet's veterinarian.
- ✓ Leash, harness or crate/kennel.
- ✓ 5+ days of food. (Can opener for wet food).
- ✓ Updated tags/licenses secured to collar.
- ✓ Current photograph of pet. (In case pet goes missing).
- ✓ List & phone numbers of pet friendly lodging. (Most disaster shelters DO NOT allow pets).
- ✓ **NEVER** leave your pets behind!
